Shillong, May 02, 2025 : Shri Shemborlang Rynjah, the newly elected Chief Executive Member (CEM) of the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council (KHADC), along with other newly elected Executive Members, Winston Tony Lyngdoh, Aibandaplin F. Lyngdoh Nonglait, Powell Sohkhlet, Seiborlang Warbah, Diety H. Majaw, Pynkhraboklin Kharjahrin, Isynei Hinge and their respective MDCs, paid a courtesy visit to the Hon'ble Governor of Meghalaya, Shri C. H. Vijayashankar, at Raj Bhavan today. The Hon'ble Governor welcomed each member in a traditional manner by felicitating them with Khasi Ryndia.

During the meeting, the Hon'ble Governor congratulated Shri Rynjah and the Executive Members on assuming office and conveyed his best wishes for their tenure.
